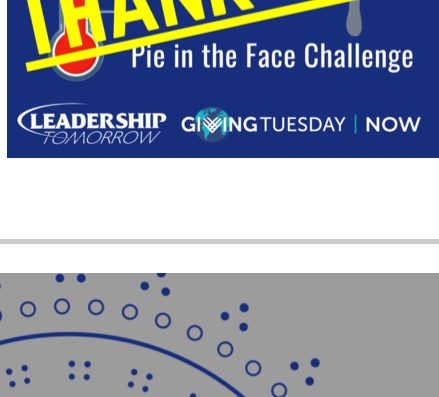


## Congratulations Class 34!

## YLT Philanthropy Grant

In May, the YLT class met via Zoom with the goal of selecting a Hall County nonprofit to receive a \$2,500 grant. At the beginning of the session, five area nonprofits joined to present and answer questions about their mission, projects, and connection to area youth. The YLT members were attentive and thoughtful in their questions. Afterward, the students ranked the nonprofits based on pre-established criteria and participated in both small- and large-group discussions. YLT Class #23 members shared viewpoints, listened to each other, asked questions, and ultimately agreed on the recipient. The Central Nebraska Council for Alcoholism and Addictions was selected as the \$2,500 grant recipient from this year's YLT class. Students mentioned their mission and need, impact on youth in Hall County, and a matching competitive grant that CNCAA secured if they received the YLT grant as reasons that stood out in the selection process.

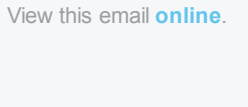
